



How did you find me?

Your mom has been telling us about herself for years. She tells us what she eats, how much she exercises, how tall she is-

and she told us that she had you! When we decided to find out all about growing up today, we asked your mom if we could talk to you. And now you are part of a HUGE group of kids from all over the United States telling us what you think and do.

Where does my booklet go after I mail it to you?

On some days, we get thousands of booklets back from kids like you— they're piled all over our offices! The first thing we do is sort them into packs of 50 each and stamp them with the date. If you told us on the outside of your envelope that you moved, we update your address in the computer— that way, your next booklet will reach you.

We check over each booklet to make sure you didn't accidentally skip anything. If any important answers are missing, we write a letter and ask you to tell us more about the question. The brand of cereal and margarine you use are assigned codes that can be read by the optical scanner.

Folders of completed surveys are taken to our optical scanner. This scanner can read as many as 7,500 sheets per hour! All of your answers are read by the scanner and stored in our computers. Finally, once all 16,000+ booklets have been coded and scanned, we begin to analyze the information that everyone has told us.
